What is Project 23?

On the Saturday before Christmas, December 23rd several years ago, we invited people in our community who were without family, friends or funds to come to St. John's for a hot delicious breakfast. Now called Project 23, in honor of the first event date, the morning includes a program with gifts, such as warm sweatshirts, underwear and socks, and hygiene and food kits which are donated by you throughout the year.

This Share Project has touched more and more lives every Christmas. Last year, over 700 people were served. This year our goal is to serve 1000!

Project 23 Hygiene Bags

Instructions:

Please assemble at least 3 hygiene bags.

All products should be FULL SIZED containers.
Please NO travel sized products.

1. Use 1 Gallon Zip Lock Bags
2. Fill bags with each of the following:
 - Shampoo
 - Conditioner
 - Bar soap
 - Deodorant
 - Hair comb
 - Dental floss
 - Toothbrush
 - Toothpaste
3. Close up bag
4. Deliver to one of the drop off locations
 - Project 23 collection sites
(bins outside worship centers or inside school office)
 - Life Group courtyard table on Sundays 9-11am
(11/23, 11/30, 12/7, 12/14)
